

## #angekommen FES Congress on Integration on 6th and 7th March 2017 in Berlin Website: www.fes.de/de/angekommen

There has been a rise in global migration and refugee movements over the past few years. According to the UNHCR, around the world 65 million people are currently fleeing from persecution, violent conflicts, precarious living conditions, and natural disasters. Particularly in 2015, a large number of refugees came to Europe and to Germany, leading to great challenges for integration policy making.

In recent months, a lot has been achieved through the large-scale efforts of numerous citizens, both in their jobs and as volunteers. But the task of creating a society in which everybody is well received and can participate has many facets. Very specific issues need to be resolved, such as access to education, the labour market, social benefits, and housing. But there is more: we need to discuss what the common framework is of a changing society of immigration and how German society can live together in diversity, equitably, and safely. For us this is not a utopia but a task to be carried out by society as a whole - especially during times when migration and integration are controversial issues.

The Friedrich Ebert Stiftung will host an international congress to assess the current situation and to provide a source of inspiration for integration policy making. On 6 and 7 March 2017, we will ask what German integration policies have already achieved, what to learn from international experiences, and what prospects future policies can generate in the interest of integration and participation. You are cordially invited to attend this congress.
