Libya's human rights challenges

Five years after the ousting of Gaddafi, Libya faces political and economic turmoil and civil war. Friedrich-Ebert-Stiftung and Lawyers for Justice in Libya present an exhibition that showcases the work of talented Libyan photographers who have captured how the current situation affects the lives and rights of Libyans.

The exhibition will be inaugurated on 15 September in the presence of photographers Aimen Ashur and Mohamed Ben Khalifa as well as women's rights activist Zahra Langhwi.

A panel discussion in German and Arabic will take place from 6pm to 7.30 pm, followed by a reception.
