There are no limits to your creativity! Whatever is best suited to bring the essence of your idea across and give us a better understanding of who your are and what drives you!

What sorts of ideas can be submitted?

Whether you want to set up a non-profit organisation, develop an app, start a journalistic project or have quite a different kind of project in mind, the sky's the limit. It doesn't matter whether this idea has just come to you, or you have had a chance to work it out in more detail. All that matters is that your idea makes a concrete contribution to a solid, democratic, and socially just society.

Who can apply?

The Progressive Democracy Lab is looking for **innovative ideas from young people between 18 and 35 years of age** who are committed the values of social democracy, take an interest in social policy issues, and would like to play an active role in tackling social policy challenges. You can apply either individually or as a team. We welcome ideas from trainees, people at the start of their careers, activists, young professionals, students, and (former) FES scholarship holders. **The call for ideas is international: you can apply from anywhere.**

What will happen with the selected ideas?

Together with other young people from diverse countries, we and our innovation coaches will help you develop your idea further. Initially, **we invite 20 teams or individuals to present their ideas in Berlin**. Out of those, we choose five ideas that our innovation coaches will help the winners make more user-friendly, productive and viable. **Finally**, **at a public event**, we award a prize of \leq 5,000 to the most promising idea to help with its real-world implementation.
